## Does the bible claim Jesus to be the, Son of God? "YES"

The bible may not contain a scripture where Jesus directly says, "I am the Son of God," or "I am God in the flesh." However there are scriptures and prophecies telling of His deity, nor did Jesus ever deny His deity. And this is also one of the reasons why Jesus was condemned to death by the religious teaches of the day.

We might think that if Jesus had told us point blank that "I am the Christ, the Son of God, that it would make this whole believing thing easier. But, it is far better to have studied this out for yourself and having come to an unmistakable conclusion than Jesus is God's only begotten Son, God in the flesh.

The list below is by no means exhaustive, but the scriptures show that Jesus is the Son of God. Through Old Testament prophecy, through His own Words and His ministry while He was on this earth, through the Father's Words, and also having been acknowledged by many witnesses.

Within the Old Testament - - - - -

- Prophecy of Christ's (the Messiah's) second coming: Daniel 9:25-26.
- Isaiah prophesied that a virgin would conceive and bring forth a Child: Isaiah 7:14 & 9:6.

Within the gospels - - - - -

- Jesus was referred to as the Word made flesh, the only begotten of the Father: John 1:14.
- Prophecy at His birth, "the Son of God", "Emmanuel": Matthew 1:23, Luke 1:35.

- Herod questioned the wise men, where the Christ would be born: Matthew 2:4.
- Gospel writers acknowledged Jesus as the Son of God: Mark 1:1, John 20:31.
- Disciples, acknowledged Jesus as the Son of God: Matthew 14:33, John 1:49, John 6:69, John 20:28.
- Some of the people said, this is the Christ: John 7:41, John 11:27.
- Many that He healed refereed to Him as the Son of David or Son of God: Matthew 8:29, Mark 3:11, Mark 5:7, Mark 10:47, Luke 4:41, Luke 8:28.
- Jewish leaders accused Jesus of being the Son of God: Matthew 27:43, John 19:7.
- The roman centurion said, Truly this man was the Son of God: Matthew 27:54, Mark 15:39.
- God acknowledged Jesus as His Son: Matthew 3:17, Mark 1:11, Mark 9:7.
- Jesus said to the Jewish leaders, "God is My Father": John 5:17.
- Jesus said, "I and My Father are one": John 10:30.
- Jesus refereed to Himself as, "I am": John 8:24, 28, John 13:19.
- Jesus said that He was the Messiah, the Son of God: Matthew 26:64, Mark 14:61, Luke 22:70, John 4:26, John 9:37, John 10:36.

New Testament teachings - - - - -

- People proclaiming Jesus as the Son of God: Acts 8:37, Acts 9:20.
- General teachings call Jesus the Son of God: Romans 1:4, 2<sup>nd</sup> Corinthians 1:19, Hebrews 4:14, 1<sup>st</sup> John 4:15, 1<sup>st</sup> John 5:5, 1<sup>st</sup> John 5:20, 2<sup>nd</sup> John 1:3, Revelation 1:1 & 2:18.
