## <u>A scriptural healing path</u>

- I am made in the image and likeness of God, having dominion over the whole earth, the fish of the sea, the birds of the air, the cattle and every creeping thing on the earth, Genesis 1:26. This is an awesome truth and understanding this foundation will give us a revelation of who we are in Christ Jesus. We are not evolved monkeys or Apes, we were made in the image of God!
- I will praise You; for I am fearfully and wonderfully made; Your works are marvelous and my soul knows it very well, Psalm 139:14.

This talks about the physical body and that God's workmanship is wonderful, and it says that our soul knows it quite well, (we just need to renew our mind and realize this truth)

- For I am the temple of God and the Spirit of God dwells within me, 1<sup>st</sup> Corinthians 3:16. Every believer is sealed with the Holy Spirit of promise, Ephesians 1:13, but we also have the privilege of having God's Spirit actively dwell and guide us, it's called the baptism of the Holy Spirit, Luke 11:13.
- But if the Spirit of the *One* who raised up Jesus from *the* dead dwells in you, the *One* who raised up Christ from *the* dead shall also make your mortal bodies alive by His Spirit who dwells in you, Romans 8:11.

If you are a believer in God and His Son, Jesus Christ, (the new birth), having His Holy Spirit actively guiding your life, (the baptism of the Holy Spirit). That same Spirit shall quicken, (make alive) your moral body. For why would God, (the all powerful Creator of the universe), wish to dwell in a sick body?

• For you are bought with a price. Therefore glorify God in your body and in your spirit, which are God's, 1<sup>st</sup> Corinthians 6:20.

You are bought with a price and your body is not your own and God wants us to glorify Him in our physical body and in our spirit, (sickness does not glorify God).

• Jesus bore our sins in His own body on the tree, that dying to sins, we might live to righteousness; by whose stripes we were healed, 2<sup>nd</sup>Peter 2:24.

Know that physical healing was done for us over two thousand years ago. It is a matter of us receiving what is rightfully ours and to do so we most-likely need to renew our mind, Romans 12:2. By standing on the truth of God's Word, submitting to God, resist the Devil and he will flee, James 4:7.

- For as I think in my heart, so am I, Proverbs 23:7. This applies to every aspect of our life and ties in very closely with:
- For with whatever judgment you judge, you shall be judged; and with whatever measure you measure out, it shall be measured to you again, Matthew 7:2.

What we believe is also, to a great deal is what we receive, If we view God as being impersonal and uncompassionate, we will receive from God as we believe He is. Why would we receive good things, (healing), from someone you believe to be less than good?, Luke 19:22.

• Bless the LORD, O my soul and forget not all His benefits, who forgives all your iniquities; who heals all your diseases, Psalm 103:2-3.

God does both, He forgives our sins and also heals our diseases. Healing is a free gift, just as salvation is a free gift, if we attempt to earn it, it is no longer a gift and we forfeit the free gift.

• for I *am* the LORD your God, {Jehovah-Rapha} who heals you, Exodus 15:27.

We are healed, not because we are good or deserving, but because He is good!
