## Healing Scriptures

Old Testament: scriptures:

- I am made in the image and likeness of God, having dominion over the whole earth, the fish of the sea, the birds of the air, the cattle and every creeping thing on the earth, Genesis 1:26.
- I will praise You; for I am fearfully and wonderfully made; Your works are marvelous and my soul knows it very well, Psalm 139:14.
- If you will diligently hearken to the the LORD, do what is right, give ear to His commandments and keep His statutes, I will put none of the diseases on you, which I have brought on the Egyptians: for I *am* the LORD, {Jehovah Rapha}, that heals you, Exodus 15:26.
- Isaiah the prophet spoke: Jesus borne our sickness and pains; yet we esteemed Him stricken, smitten and afflicted of God. But He was wounded for my transgressions; bruised for my iniquities; the chastisement of my peace was on Him; and with His stripes I was healed, Isaiah 53:4-5.
- Bless the LORD, O my soul and forget not all His benefits, who forgives all my iniquities; who heals all my diseases, Psalm 103:2-3.
- He sent His Word, and healed me, and delivered me from my destructions, Psalm 107:20.
- He heals the broken in heart, and binds up their wounds, Psalm 147:3.
- When I lie down, I shall not be afraid; and my sleep shall be sweet, Proverbs 3:24.
- For as I think in my heart, so am I, Proverbs 23:7.

New Testament scriptures:

- And I will meditate on things that are true, honest, just, pure and of good report, Philippians 4:8.
- For I am the temple of God and the Spirit of God dwells within me, 1<sup>st</sup> Corinthians 3:16.
- But if the Spirit of Him that raised up Jesus from the dead dwell in you, He that raised up Christ from the dead shall also quicken your mortal bodies by His Spirit that dwells in you, Romans 8:11.
- Many were brought to Him that were possessed with devils: and He cast out the spirits with His Word, and healed <u>all</u> that were sick: That it would be fulfilled that was spoken by Isaiah the prophet, saying, Jesus took our infirmities, and bare my sickness, Matthew 8:16-17.
- Jesus bore my sins in His own body on the tree, that dying to sins, I might live to righteousness; by whose stripes I were healed, 1<sup>st</sup> Peter 2:24.
- And the whole multitude sought to touch Him: for there went virtue out of Him, and healed *them* all, Luke 6:19.
- The Lord has given me power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall hurt me, Luke 10:19.
- Then Peter said, Silver and gold I do not have; but such as I have, I give to you: In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth rise up and walk, Acts 3:6.
- And make straight paths for your feet, (walking in the truth of God's Word), lest that which is lame be turned out of the way, (least the lame be discouraged); but let it rather be healed, Hebrews 12:13.
- <sup>14</sup> Is any sick among you? let him call for the elders of the church; and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord: <sup>15</sup> And the prayer of faith shall save the sick, and the Lord shall raise him up; and if he have committed sins, they shall be forgiven him. <sup>16</sup> Confess *your* faults one to another, and pray one for another, that ye may be healed. The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man avails much, James 5:14-16.
