# **Morning confessions**

#### Putting on the full armor of God,

Ephesians 6:13-18

- v 13- Therefore, take to yourselves the whole armor of God, that you may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand.
- v 14- Having your loins (your core foundation), girt about with the truth of Gods Word,
- v 14 Putting on the breastplate of righteousness, (protecting your heart, to keep it pure);
- v 15 Having prepared yourself to walk in the in the peace of the gospel, (not being moved or shaken by the fiery trials that we go through);
- v 16 Most important, taking the shield of faith, that you will be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked one.
- v 17 Taking up the helmet of salvation, (to guard your mind and to assure you of your salvation).
- v 17 And the sword of the Spirit, which is the Word of God, (to be able to do battle with):
- v 18 Praying, always with all prayer in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all saints;

#### Asking for one's daily bread and for wisdom.

Reciting of the Lord's prayer, Matthew 6:9-13. ... give us today our daily bread, ... (our daily instructions), and grant us the wisdom needed for the day, James 1:5.

### Using my spiritual authority.
