Teaching: "The kingdom of God is within you"

Saying, The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand: repent ye, and believe the gospel, Mark 1:15.

The kingdom of God comes not with observation: for the kingdom of God is within you, Luke 17:20-21.

The kingdom of God is first and foremost a way of thinking and of living, knowing and having a relationship with God and His Son Jesus, acknowledging that His Spirit lives within you, resulting in love, peace and joy.

Jesus said much about the kingdom of God.

Seek ye first the kingdom of God and His righteousness and all these things shall be add unto you, Matthew 6:33.

Unto you it is given to know the mystery of the kingdom of God, Luke 4:11.

There shall be some of you that before they taste of death shall see the kingdom of God come with power, Mark 9:1.

We can also learn from the parables.

The kingdom of God, as if a man should cast seed into the ground; sleep, and rise night and day, and the seed should spring and grow up, he knows not how, Mark 4:26-27.

The kingdom of God is like a grain of mustard seed, which, when sown in the earth, is less than all the seeds that be in the earth: But becomes greater than all herbs, Mark 4:32.

It is like leaven, which a woman took and hid in three measures of meal, till the whole was leavened, Luke 13:21.
