Teaching: "Who we are in Christ"

Our perception of ourself is what matters.

Abraham, how he saw himself vis. others:

- I am a stranger and a sojourner with you, Genesis 23:4.
- Thou *art* a mighty prince among us, Genesis 23:6.

Moses, how he saw himself vis. NT. Scripture.

- Moses said to the LORD, I am slow of speech, Exodus 4:10.
- Moses was mighty in words and in deeds, Acts 7:22.

The 12 spies, what they said vis. their enemies.

- We were in our own sight as grasshoppers and also in their sight, Numbers 13:33.
- That your terror is fallen upon us, and that all the inhabitants of the land faint because of you, Joshua 2:9.

These examples are from the OT. But as New Testament believers we need to know / believe the promises of God.

Now we are under a better covenant:

Beloved, now are we the sons of God, and it does not yet appear what we shall be: but we know that, when He shall appear, we shall be like Him; for we shall see Him as He is, 1st John 3:2.

If then you were raised with Christ, seek those things which are above, Colossians 3:1.

If ye continue in My Word, *then* are ye My disciples indeed; And ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free, John 31-32.
