Teaching: "the true worshipers"

The true worshipers shall worship the Father in spirit and in truth: for the Father seeks such to worship Him. God *is* a Spirit: and they that worship Him must worship *Him* in spirit and in truth, John 4:23-24.

Worship is more than just singing and dancing.

Knowing, living, speaking and sharing the truth of God's Word is a form of worship,

The importance of worship:

Satan also desires our worship, Matthew 4:9, Luke 4:7.

Whom you serve, to him you become his servant, Romans 6:16.

However, It is also possible to offer God false worship:

Teaching commandments of men, Matthew 15:9, Mark 7:7.

The Pharisees praying on the street corner,

The Greeks worshiping an UNKNOWN GOD, Acts 17:23.

Worship of the creature more than the Creator, Rom 1:25.

We can worship the Lord wherever we are.

We worship God in the spirit, and rejoice in Christ Jesus, and have no confidence in the flesh, Philippians 3:3.

A few final thoughts:

God alone is worthy of worship, Mat 4:10, Hebrews 1:6, Rev 22:9.

Offer God the sacrifice of praise, Hebrews 13:15.

It is easier to work up a feeling through an action, than to work up an action through a feeling.

The scriptures do not say, your flesh will worship Me, our spirit worships Him, our flesh merely goes along for the ride.
