Teaching: "It's all about Jesus"

Whom do men say that I the Son of man am? Matt 16:13, But whom say ye that I am? Mark 8:27, Luke 9:18.

This question is to reveal, not to gain information. Example: story of Jacob, what is your name, Gen 32:27. We must also have a personal revelation of Jesus.

He is the Word made flesh, John 1:14.

He is the express image of the Father, **Hebrews 1:3**.

He is the Lamb that bore away our sins, John 1:29.

He is the giver of abundant life, John 10:10.

He is the Almighty God, Revelations 21:22.

He is our eternal High Priest, Hebrews 3:1, ...

He was made flesh, so He could . . .

Relate to His brethern, *(us)*, **Hebrews 2:11**.

Tempted like as we are, yet without sin, **Hebrews 4:15**.

Conquer sin, and reconcile us to the Father, **Hebrews 2:17**.

It's all about Him, so that no man can boast.

For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: *it is* the gift of God: Not of works, lest any man should boast, **Ephesians 2:8-9**.

Therefore, simply believe & rest in Him.

That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved, **Romans 10:9**.

Let us labor therefore to enter into that rest, lest any man fall after the same example of unbelief, **Hebrews 4:11**.

For nothing is too hard for the Lord, **Ephesians 3:20**.
