why are they all in parables?

To you it is given to know the mystery of the kingdom of God: but to them that are without, *these* things are in parables:

That seeing they may see and not perceive; hearing they may hear and not understand; lest they be forgiven.

The parable of the sower: 4 – types of ground

1). seed on the wayside

The enemy immediately steals the Word

2). seed on stony places

They have no root, and become offended

3). seed among the thorns

Cares of the world choke the Word and is unfruitful

4). seed on good ground

Hear and receive the Word, bring forth fruit

He that has ears let him hear,

Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceeds out of the mouth of God, Matthew 4:4.

The parable of the germinating seed.

The kingdom of God is as a man scatter seed in the ground. He sleeps and rises night and day, and the seed grows, he knows not how.

For the earth brings forth fruit of herself, Mark 4:26,28.

The kingdom of God is as a mustard seed when sown, is less than all the seeds that be in the earth: and grows and becomes greater than all herbs.

The seed is the Word of God, The soil is our hearts Man's heart will bring forth whatever seed planted for every tree produces after its own kind, Luke 6:44.
