Teaching: "Resurrection Power"

I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God, for if Christ be not risen, then *is* our preaching vain, and your faith *is* also vain, {Romans 1:16 & 1st Corinthians 15:14}.

Christ crucified and raised from the dead.

We preach Christ crucified, unto the Jews a stumblingblock, and unto the Greeks foolishness, 1st Corinthians 1:23.

He was crucified through weakness, yet He lives by the power of God. For we also are weak in Him, but we shall live with Him by the power of God toward you, 2nd Corinthians 13:4.

I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless; Christ lives in me: and the life I live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me, {Galatians 2:20}.

Calling things forth that be not as though they are.

I have made thee a father of many nations, before Him whom he believed, *even* God, who quickens the dead, and calls those things which be not as though they were, Romans 4:7.

For verily I say unto you, whosoever you shall say and doubt not in his heart, but believe that those things shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith. Therefore I say unto you, What things you desire, when you pray, believe that you receive *them*, and ye shall have *them*. {Mark 11:23-24}.

Our hope of heaven and the many blessings of God.

From that time Jesus began to preach, and to say, Repent: for the kingdom of heaven is at hand, Matthew 4:17.

The hope which is laid up for you in heaven, whereof ye heard before in the word of the truth of the gospel, Colossians 1:5.

For the Lord Himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first, 1st Thessalonians 4:16.

The power of the Gospel Christ Risen from the dead

- For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ: for it is the power
 of God unto salvation to every one that believeth; to the Jew
 first, and also to the Greek, Romans 1:16.
- And if Christ be not risen, then is our preaching vain, and your faith is also vain, 1st Corinthians 15:14.
- Beware lest any man spoil you through philosophy and vain deceit, after the tradition of men, after the rudiments of the world, and not after Chris, Colossians 2:8.
- * For I determined not to know any thing among you, save Jesus Christ, and Him crucified. . . That your faith should not stand in the wisdom of men, but in the power of God. . . But we speak the wisdom of God in a mystery, even the hidden wisdom, which God ordained before the world unto our glory: . . . But God has revealed them unto us by His Spirit: for the Spirit searches all things, yea, the deep things of God. . . Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the Spirit which is of God; that we might know the things that are freely given to us of God. . . But the natural man receives not the things of the Spirit of God: for they are foolishness unto him: neither can he know them, because they are spiritually discerned. . . For who has known the mind of the Lord, that he may instruct Him? But we have the mind of Christ, 1st Corinthians 2:2,5,7,10,12,14,16.
