  - ♦ delivered: - **Colossians 1:13, Romans 7:6**
  - ♦ forgiven: - **Ephesians 4:32, Colossians 2:13**
  - ♦ sanctified: - **1<sup>st</sup> Corinthians 6:11**
  - ♦ healed: - **Luke 6:18, Acts 5:16, Acts 8:7, 28:9, 1<sup>st</sup> Peter 2:24**
  - ♦ been made whole: **Matthew 9:22**

### **Saved:**

### **Redeemed:**

Christ has redeemed us from the curse of the law, being made a curse for us: for it is written, Cursed *is* every one that hangs on a tree: , *Galatians 3:13.*

### **Delivered:**

Who has delivered us from the power of darkness, and has translated *us* into the kingdom of His dear Son:, *Colossians 1:13.*

### **Forgiven:**

And you, being dead in your sins and the uncircumcision of your flesh, has He quickened together with Him, having forgiven you all trespasses; , *Colossians 2:13.*

### **Sanctified:**

By the which will we are sanctified through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once *for all*, *Hebrews 10:10.*

### **Healed & Whole:**

Who His own self bare our sins in His own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: by whose stripes ye were healed, *1<sup>st</sup> Peter 2:24.*
