## Teaching: "The Earth Lease"

## Six thousand years ;;; and soon after the rapture.

There is a set destined time, Matthew 8:29

This timing of Christ in certain events.

<u>The Transfiguration of Jesus</u>, Matthew 17:1, Mark 9:2, Luke 9:28 after 6 day, Jesus took Peter, James & John up a mountain. Jesus transfigured on the 7 day. All accounts is before are all alike, Jesus asking the 12, who do they say that I am? After that Jesus saying; For the Son of man shall come in the glory of His Father with His angels;.

(the whole scripture is on the back, Matthew 16:24-28).

<u>The raising of Lazarus</u>, Jesus arrived on the 4<sup>th</sup> day. Jesus waited 2 days, a days journey there, one day for the messenger.

We can see Christ's timing in parables.

Parable of the good Samaritan, Luke 10:30. The good Samaritan (Jesus came on day 4), gave the inn keeper (the church), 2 day expenses and said; WHEN I COME BACK. . .

Hidden / symbolic language within scriptures.

The LORD said, My spirit shall not always strive with man, for that he also *is* flesh: yet his days shall be an hundred and twenty years, Genesis 6:3.

120 times 50 (a Sabbath Jubilee) == 6000

Man's day are recorded in, Psalm 90:10

The days of our years *are* threescore years and ten, . . 80.

- But unto you that fear My name shall the Sun of righteousness arise with healing in His wings; and ye shall go forth, and grow up as calves of the stall, Malachi 4:2.
- If any *man* will come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross, and follow Me. For whosoever will save his life shall lose it: and whosoever will lose his life for My sake shall find it. For what is a man profited, if he shall gain the whole world, and lose his own soul? or what shall a man give in exchange for his soul? For the Son of man shall come in the glory of His Father with His angels; and then He shall reward every man according to his works. Verily I say unto you, There be some standing here, which shall not taste of death, till they see the Son of man coming in His kingdom, Matthew 16:24-28.
- After this I looked, and, behold, a door *was* opened in heaven: and the first voice which I heard *was* as it were of a trumpet talking with me; which said, Come up hither, and I will shew thee things which must be hereafter, Revelation 4:1.
