Teaching: "Wisdom, it's the principle thing."

Jesus / God, wants us to be wise and have understanding"

when He had called all the people *unto Him,* He said unto them, Hearken unto Me every one of you, and understand: Mark 7:14. Wisdom *is* the principal thing; *therefore* get wisdom: and with all thy getting get understanding, Proverbs 4:7.

We must know the promises within Word.

Without knowing what the Word says is rightfuly ours, we will go without those promises.

And ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free, John 8:32.

However, it is only the truth that you know that will make you free.

For we all have a personal gospel, Romans 2:16, 2nd Timothy 2:8.

For with what judgment ye judge, ye shall be judged: and with what measure ye mete, it shall be measured to you again.

Matthew 7:2.

For as he thinks in his heart, so is he: Proverbs 23:7a,b.

From a parable: Out of thine own mouth will I judge thee, Luke 19:22.

The kingdom of God or heaven works on, our thoughts, our beliefs, our words.

Therefore:

Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ;, 2nd Corinthians 10:5.

Think about what is: true, honest, just, pure, lovely, of good report; if *there be* any virtue, and praise, Philippians 4:8.

- Wherefore be ye not unwise, but understanding what the will of the Lord is, Ephesians 5:17.
