Gifts, from the Godhead, concerning our body.

The Father's gift to mankind:

²⁷ So God created man in His *own* image, in the image of God created He him; male and female created He them. ²⁸ And God blessed them, and God said unto them, Be fruitful, and multiply, and replenish the earth, and subdue it:, Genesis 1:27-28.

(We are made in God's image and likeness having the ability and responsibility to operate in the supernatural realm).

The Son's gift to mankind:

I will praise Thee; for I am fearfully *and* wonderfully made: marvelous *are* Thy works; and *that* my soul knows right well, Psalms 139:14.

For who has known the mind of the Lord, that he may instruct Him? But we have the mind of Christ, 1st Corinthians 2:16.

(Our body is fearfully and wonderfully made, (it can heal itself), our soul knows it quite well, (we just need to educate our mind, for we have the mind of Christ).

The Holy Spirit's gift to mankind:

But if the Spirit of Him that raised up Jesus from the dead dwell in you, He that raised up Christ from the dead shall also quicken your mortal bodies by His Spirit that dwells in you, Romans 8:11.

(If we acknowledge His Spirit dwelling within us, we have the Healer (Jehovah-Rapha), living within us).

Every aspect of our body, our total being is of God.

What? know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost *which is* in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own? For ye are bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body, and in your spirit, which are God's, 1st Corinthians 6:19-20.

Physical healing was prophesied in the Old Testament.

Surely He has borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows: yet we did esteem Him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted. But He *was* wounded for our transgressions, *He was* bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace *was* upon Him; and with His stripes we are healed, Isaiah 53:4-5.

And Jesus fulfilled this Old Testament prophecy.

When the even was come, they brought unto Him many that were possessed with devils: and He cast out the spirits with *His* Word, and healed all that were sick: That it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Esaias the prophet, saying, Himself took our infirmities, and bare *our* sicknesses, Matthew 8:16-17.

Who His own self bare our sins in His own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: by whose stripes ye were healed, 1st Peter 2:24.

For the Word of God *is* quick, and powerful, and sharper than any twoedged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow, and *is* a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart, Hebrews 4:12.

(As a child of God, we should not settle for less than the total healing that Jesus Christ gained for us on the cross).

We need to develop a righteous indignation.

Be ye angry, and sin not: let not the sun go down upon your wrath: Neither give place to the devil, Ephesians 4:26-27.

(We must remain angry at the devil and his works (sickness). For he comes to only steal, kill and destroy, John 10:10).

Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you. James 4:7.

⁵ For they that are after the flesh do mind the things of the flesh; but they that are after the Spirit the things of the Spirit. ⁶ For to be carnally minded *is* death; but to be spiritually minded *is* life and peace. Romans 8:5-6.

¹⁴ Is any sick among you? let him call for the elders of the church; and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord: ¹⁵ And the prayer of faith shall save the sick, and the Lord shall raise him up; and if he have committed sins, they shall be forgiven him. James 5:14-15.

Forever, O LORD, thy Word is settled in heaven, Psalms 119:89. (God's Word is extablished in heaven, we need to extablish His Word in our hearts, while here on this earth).

But thanks be to God, which gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ. 1st Corinthians 15:57.

Speak to the issues in your body, for God gave mankind dominion over all the earth, at creation, Genesis 1:26, and we are made of the dust of the earth. Therefore, speak to your body. For we have not, because we ask not, James 4:2.

²³ For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith. ²⁴ Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive *them*, and ye shall have *them*. Mark 11:23-24.
