

Did God make / create the darkness, (evil)? God is not the author of evil

According to Isaiah 45:7, it seems to say He is.

I form the light, and create darkness: I make peace, and create evil: I the LORD do all these *things*,
[Isaiah 45:7](#).

Below, I linked a few scriptures together to help explain that God creates in the light, walks in the light and is light

God created all things, but He is not the author of evil

All that God created, earth, birds, fish, beasts & man were said to be good or very good, [Genesis chapter 1](#).
God created all things, [John 1:3](#), least we accredit Satan as being able to create.

God is light and He walks in the light.

God is light, and in Him is no darkness at all, [1st John 1:5](#). (God is absolutely good).

But if we walk in the light, as He is in the light, we have fellowship one with another, and the blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanseth us from all sin, [1st John 1:7](#).

Explanation.

When Lucifer fell from heaven and became known as Satan, he rejected God. Therefore he works in darkness or shades of darkness. God's absence is darkness, and Satan chose this to be his realm. Whereby God's absence caused the darkness to exist, God did not create the evil that Satan would then orchestrate.

Why Isaiah 45:7, might say it this way, is that the works and understanding of the devil, satan was not fully known or even discussed in the Old Testament, other than in the book of Job. And God's absence did cause the darkness, and therefore the evil that satan would cause to exist.
