# Teaching: "Entering the Rest."

## In the old testament, God planned a rest for His people.

For if Joshua had given them rest, he would not have spoken afterward of another day. There remains therefore a sabbath rest for the people of God, Hebrews 4:8-9

## The Sabbath day, a type and shadow of the rest to come.

Let no man therefore judge you in meat, or in drink, or in respect of a feast day or a new moon or a <u>sabbath day</u>: which are a shadow of the things to come; but the body is Christ's, Colossians 2:16-17

### The Sabbath day and the Lord's day.

Saturday – Sabbath, the seventh day God rested, Genesis 2:2. Sunday - the Lord's day, first day of the week, Matthew 28:1.

#### Jesus is our Sabbath rest.

He said unto them, The sabbath was made for man, and not man for the sabbath: so that the Son of man is Lord even of the sabbath, Mark 2:27-28 also Luke 6:5, Matthew 12:8.

Jesus is now our rest, we need to rest in Him 24/7 and not just one day a week.

#### We must labor to enter into His rest.

Therefore let us labor to enter into that rest, lest anyone fall after the same example of unbelief, Hebrews 4 11.

You shall find Him, if you seek with all your heart and soul, Deut 4:29.

He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him, Hebrews 11:6.

And he did the evil because he did not prepare his heart to seek Jehovah, 2<sup>nd</sup> Chronicles 12:14.

Note: We spend our time on what is important to us.
