## Old Testament prophecy, Isaiah 53:4,5

New Testament fulfillment, Matthew 8:16,17

Surely, He has borne our *griefs* And carried our *sorrows*; Yet, we esteemed Him stricken, Smitten by God, and afflicted. But, He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities; The chastisement for our peace was upon Him, And by His stripes we are healed.

And He cast out the spirits with a word, and healed all who were sick, that it might be fulfilled, which was spoken by Isaiah the prophet, saying: He Himself took our *infirmities* And bore our *sicknesses*.

Griefs and Sorrows can also be interpreted sickness / disease, pain. Strong's Greek / Hebrew definitions are:

griefs = OT2483, choliy (khol-ee'); malady, anxiety, calamity: KJV - disease, grief, (is) sick (-ness).

sorrows = OT4341. (mak-obe, mak-obe, mak-o-baw); anguish or (figuratively) affliction: KJV - grief, pain, sorrow.

- for I am the LORD that healeth thee. 1<sup>st</sup> Exodus 15:26.
- Who Himself bore our sins in His own body on the tree, that we, having died to sins, might live for righteousness--by whose stripes you were healed, 1<sup>st</sup> Peter 2:24.
- Bless the LORD, O my soul, and forget not all His benefits: Who forgives all your iniquities, Who heals all your diseases, Psalm 103:2-3.
- He sent his word, and healed them, and delivered them from their destructions, Psalm 107:20.
- But if the Spirit of Him that raised up Jesus from the dead dwell in you, He that raised up Christ from the dead shall also quicken your mortal bodies by His Spirit that dwells in you. Romans 8:11.
- What? know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost which is in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own? For ye are bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body, and in your spirit, which are God's. 1<sup>st</sup> Corinthians 6:19-20.
- I will praise Thee; for I am fearfully and wonderfully made: marvelous are Thy works; and that my soul knows right well Psalm 139:14.
