Who do you think of as your Father?

• All of us grew up with some pattern of an earthly dad, (whether present or absent). Even though we may acknowledge that God is our Father, that does not negate our past experience. We need to believe with our whole heart that God is our Father, knowing that God is a good God.

And call no *man* your father upon the earth: for one is your Father, which is in heaven, Matthew 23:9.

Who is your life patterned after?

- Earthly idols, stars, sports figures, your parents or is it patterned against your heavenly Father?
- You have heard it said of a son, when he reaches a certain age, that, "he is just like his dad". This is nearly always meant of his earthly dad, and may or may not be a complement.
- However, pattern your life after your heavenly Father, who is in heaven.

Your heavenly Father desires to bless you

• However, receiving the blessing is up to you, you need to cooperate with His plans for your life.

For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, says the LORD, thoughts of peace and not of evil, to give you a future and a hope, Jeremiah 29:11.
