Creating an atmosphere of glory, allows God to move in our lives!

You create and choose your own atmosphere.

Death and life are in the power of the tongue, and those who love it will eat its fruit, Proverbs 18:21. You can either create an atmosphere of life or death with your tongue, (choose life), worship God, and create an atmosphere of glory.

Doing this goes against the negativity of the world, but know that it is well worth it. The world will not guild you into this, therefore you must choose to go it alone.

The atmosphere in heaven is not one of gloom and depression but one of glory.

Therefore, do as the Lord's prayer tells us to do; Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done in earth, as *it is* in heaven, Matthew 6:10. If you want to see the power of God in our lives, emulate the atmosphere of heaven.

The Son of Man shall come in His glory, with the holy angels, He shall then sit upon the throne of His glory, Matthew 25:31.

We create our own glory level.

Step out of your comfort zone, get radical and dance as if no ones looking, give Him the sacrifice of praise; By him therefore let us offer the sacrifice of praise to God continually, that is, the fruit of *our* lips giving thanks to His name, Hebrew 13:15.

Give unto the LORD the glory due to His name. Worship the LORD in the beauty of holiness, Psalm 29:2.

Be thankful to the Lord, (of what He has brought you through).

Singing, praising and worshiping God, through singing hymns and psalms.

The power within an atmosphere of Glory

And at midnight Paul and Silas prayed, and sang praises unto God: and the prisoners heard them. And suddenly there was a great earthquake, so that the foundations of the prison were shaken: and immediately all the doors were opened, and everyone's bands were loosed, Acts 16:25-26. One of the amassing things in this situation was that not one of the prisons left the prison, Acts 16:28, everyone was caught up in the atmosphere of glory.

The whole earth will be filled with His glory.

But as truly as I live, all the earth shall be filled with the glory of the LORD, Numbers 14:21.
