Pluralism, claims all religions to be equal and valid.

The definition of pluralism is:

- The holding by one person, of two or more offices at the same time.
- The doctrine that there is more than one kind of ultimate reality.
- A theory that reality is composed of a plurality of entities.

A double minded man *is* unstable in all his ways, James 1:8.

Be ye not unequally yoked together with unbelievers: for what fellowship has righteousness with unrighteousness? and <u>what communion has light with darkness</u>? 2nd Corinthians 6:14.

Questions to consider to address this issue:

- There is every religion from: belief in Christ, eastern religions, humanism, witchcraft, Satan worshipers, etc. What ones are valid, are they all valid, and if not, what is your criteria for separating the good from the bad?
- If you highlight everything, you actually highlight nothing. It is hypercritical to believe that contradicting values or philosophies can all be acceptable and true.

To those who are in Christ Jesus.

But ye *are* a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, an holy nation, a peculiar people; that ye should shew forth the praises of Him who has called you out of darkness into His marvelous light, 1st Peter 2:9.
