

Teaching: the Sacrifice of Praise

God expects / instructs His people to praise Him.

So that we might praise the Lord. ... **Leviticus 19:24**

King David, setting up the tabernacle

4,000 appointed to praise the Lord. ... **1 Chronicles 23:5**

God inhabits the praises of His people (Israel), **Ps 22:3**

Give to the LORD the glory due to His name, Ps 29:2

His praise always *shall be* in my mouth. ... Psalm 34:1

Jonah gave thanks to the Lord, in the belly of the fish

I will sacrifice with the voice of thanksgiving. ... **Jonah 2:9**

Jesus knew the importance of praise & worship

Whoever you worship becomes your Master. ... **Luke 4:6-8**

God moved on Paul & Silas praises in prison

At midnight, and the prisoners heard them. ... **Acts 16:25**

Glorify God in your body and spirit,

For your body is of God, for

you were bought with a price. ... **1 Corinthians 6:20**

God can move mightily within an atmosphere of praise

Giving praise with a thankful heart creates an atmosphere of glory, and God inhabits (can move in) His peoples praises.

Praise is like the fuel needed to move a vehicle,

“our earthly tent”, without praise we will not go to far!
