

Teaching: “The many names of God”

Yahweh"- # OT:3068, “self Existent, Eternal God”.

Adonai"- # OT:136, “(my) Lord” {used as a proper name}.

Combining Yahweh & Adonai together gives us, “Jehovah”

El-Shaddai – “God Almighty” or “God All Sufficient”

Elohim – # OT:430, the fullness of God's divine perfection.

Jehovah-Jireh - - - “the Lord will provide”.

Provided ram in place of Isaac - sacrifice, [Genesis 22:14](#).

Jehovah-Rapha - - - “the Lord our healer”.

No diseases of the Egyptians, I am your healer, [Exodus 15:26](#).

Jehovah-Nissi – – – the Lord our (*victory*) banner”

Moses built an altar, after defeat of Amalekites, [Exodus 17:15](#).

Jehovah-Mekaddish – – – the Lord who Sanctifies

if you keep My Sabbaths, as a sign to Me, [Exodus 31:13](#).

Jehovah-Shalom – – – “the Lord our peace”

Gideon named the altar in Ophrah, [Judges 6:24](#).

Jehovah-Rohi - - - “the Lord my shepherd”.

The Lord is my shepherd, I shall not want, [Psalm 23:1](#).

Jehovah-Sabboth – – The Lord of Hosts, of the armies).

I will avenge Myself of mine enemies, [Isaiah 1:24](#).

Jehovah-Tsidkenu - - - “the Lord our righteousness”.

And His name shall be called, [Jeremiah 23:6 & 33:16](#).

Jehovah-Shammah – – the Lord is there”, (*is present*).

The city that the prophet Ezekiel saw in a vision, [Ezekiel 48:35](#).
