## Teaching: on praise

---

**Genesis 29:35**; First instance of praise in the bible  
Leah giving birth to her 4<sup>th</sup> child (*Judah*),  
“now I will praise the Lord”  
she waited for a circumstance to praise the Lord.

**Hebrews 13:15**; Give Him the sacrifice of praise.  
Praise can be a sacrifice, sometimes we just don't feel  
like doing it. (do it regardless of how you feel).

**Psalms 111 through 113**; Starts with praise.  
Praise ye the LORD.

**Psalms 146 through 150**; Ends with Praise.  
Let everything that has breath praise the Lord.

Both are in book 5, (107-150), the last book of Psalms  
each book is a progression, a life journey, ending in praise.

---

**Luke 1:64**; And his mouth was opened immediately, (*Zacharias*)  
praised the lord.

**Matthew 21:16**; **Out of the mouth of babes and  
sucklings thou has perfected praise.**

**Psalms 8:2**; Out of the mouth of babes and sucklings  
has thou ordained strength because of thine enemies, that  
thou mightiest still the enemy and the avenger.  
praise becomes our strength to still the enemy,  
without praising the Lord, we forfeit receiving many of the  
Lord's blessings and provisions.

**Acts 16:24**; Praising the Lord creates an atmosphere of glory,  
great things can happen when we praise Him.

**Revelation 19:1-6**;  
Alleluia: for the Lord God omnipotent reigneth.  
Even heaven occupies praise.
