

Teaching: “Principles of Faith.”

Faith and fear have the same process in common.

Both expect something to happen that has not happened.

If you can process one, you have the ability for the other.

We all have the capability to operate in faith.

Simon Peter, a servant and an apostle of Jesus Christ, to them that have obtained like precious faith with us through the righteousness of God and our Saviour Jesus Christ: **2nd Peter 1:1.**

Both fear & faith are driven by knowledge, (what we believe).

And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what *is* that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God, **Romans 12:2.**

Do we believe the world's system above the Word or do we believe God's Word and promises above the Word's ways ?

No servant can serve two masters: for either he will hate the one, and love the other; or else he will hold to the one, and despise the other. Ye cannot serve God and mammon,

Luke 16:13, Matthew 6:24.

An atmosphere of fear spreads, (it is contagious).

Whereby an atmosphere of faith does not spread,

We are the one's responsible to carry our own faith.

We must: “build ourselves up on our most holy faith, praying in the Holy Ghost,” **Jude 1:20.**

We must: often put ourselves and others in remembrance of these things, **2nd Peter 1:12.**

Be bold, be daring, step out in faith, ask **B I G**

we have a **B I G** God.

Magnify God rather than the works of the devil.

Faith is a new testament precept.

- ♦ And **the just shall live by faith**, Romans 1:17, Galatians 3:11 & Hebrews 10:38.
- ♦ for **we go from faith to faith**, Romans 1:17.
- ♦ Jesus answering saith unto them, **Have faith in God**, Mark 11:22.
- ♦ Verily I say unto you, **If ye have faith, and doubt not**, ye shall not only do this *which is done* to the fig tree, but also if ye shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; it shall be done. And **all things, whatsoever ye shall ask in prayer, believing, ye shall receive**, Matthew 21:21-22.
- ♦ “and **the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God**, who loved me, and gave Himself for me”, Galatians 2:20.
- ♦ Therefore **we conclude that a man is justified by faith** without the deeds of the law, Romans 3:28.
- ♦ **Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen**, Hebrews 11:1.
- ♦ Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believes on Me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater *works* than these shall he do; because I go unto My Father, John 14:12.
