

Definition of "SŌSŌ": Strong's #G4982

To: deliver or protect (literally or figuratively); heal, preserve, save (self), do well, be (make) whole

SŌSŌ is an all-encompassing word; the KJV has translated this Greek word to be: save(d), healed, made whole and preserved.

Therefore, your healing has been granted to you; you must by faith believe it and receive it and then enforce your healing.

So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the Word of God, **Romans 10:17** (KJV).

So trust comes from what is heard, and what is heard comes through a Word proclaimed about the Messiah, **Romans 10:17** (Complete Jewish Bible).

A born-again believer's definition of "faith": Faith is a heart issue, having full assurance and confidence in God's Word, knowing that God is absolutely good and has good plans for His people.

So very often our level of faith is limited to our understanding of what the world has to offer us, and likewise, we get what we are believing for. We **MUST** see God as being absolutely good, knowing that His wishes are to bless His people.

Let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience, and our bodies washed with pure water, **Hebrews 10:22**.

And being fully persuaded that, what He had promised, He was able also to perform, **Romans 4:21**.

Speak God's Word boldly; faith does not wait for physical evidence to be there, faith creates it. The moment you start speaking God's Word in faith, things will change in the spiritual realm; however, faith that is silent – is incomplete.

Yea, a man may say, Thou has faith, and I have works: show me thy faith without thy works, and I will show thee my faith by my works. **James 2:18**.

But someone will say that you have faith and I have actions. Show me this faith of yours without the actions, and I will show you my faith by my actions! **James 2:18** (Complete Jewish Bible)

We must know our authority in Christ Jesus.

From the time of creation, God gave mankind authority over all the works of the enemy, for when God created man, He gave them (male and female) dominion over all things on the earth and told them to subdue the earth, **Genesis 1:26**. Thus, we are to use our authority to prevent the evil plans and schemes of the enemy and bring righteousness back into the world's system.

Remember, I have given you authority; so you can trample down snakes and scorpions, indeed, all the Enemy's forces; and you will remain completely unharmed, **Luke 10:19**. (Complete Jewish Bible).

We were given this authority to take control of and subdue our spiritual enemy, the god of this world, **2nd Corinthians 4:4**.

The thief comes not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly, **John 10:10**.

Therefore, boldly speak the Word.

Healing does not come by casual contact but by the saturation of the Word. The Word is a healing force; it comes from believing the truth of God's Word above the facts of the world.

Death and life are in the power of the tongue: and they that love it shall eat the fruit thereof, **Proverbs 18:21**.

Your tongue can destroy your body or heal it. Speaking the Word is not vain repetition, it is spiritual warfare.

²³ For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith. ²⁴ Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them. **Mark 11:23-24**.

A silent believer – is a powerless believer;
do not be ashamed to speak God's Word.

God never intended His Word to be silently read and understood; He spoke the world into existence. He did not solely think all into existence; even our salvation requires us to confess and believe, **Romans 10:9**. God's power is voice activated;
Therefore, boldly speak His Word.

Prayer for healing and wholeness:

And through Your Holy Spirit, may be able to speak boldly making known the good news of the gospel and Your many blessings.

Healing teaching

God wants you well.

4 healing components

- *Knowing that God wants you well.*
- *Boldly speaking God's Word.*
- *Receiving your healing by faith.*
- *Having the authority to keep it.*

Healing always starts in the spiritual realm. God's Word is a living seed; we must nourish it until it takes root.

Blessed *be* the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with all spiritual blessings in heavenly *places* in Christ: **Ephesians 1:3**.

Many people use the excuse, perhaps even believing that Jesus bought for us only "spiritual healing"; this is a lie from the devil. Just as God has brought salvation to mankind through the death and Resurrection of Jesus Christ, physical healing was also brought forth through His Son.

*Healing, the same as salvation, is by grace through faith, **Ephesians 2:8**. For when Jesus took stripes at the whipping post, He endured physical wounds to provide our physical healing. We do not doubt that Jesus has secured salvation for us; why do we then doubt that Jesus will heal us?*

Who His own self bare our sins in His own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: by whose stripes ye were healed, **1st Peter 2:24**.

*We can see in the crucifixion that Jesus met all of our needs, both spiritually and physically. Spiritually: this is evident when Jesus sweat drops of blood in the garden, **Luke 22:44**, and when He was on the cross and said, "My God, why have You forsaken Me?" **Mark 15:34**. And physically, He endured the stripes, the crown of thorns forced on His head, the carrying of the cross, and the nails in His hands and feet.*
