

The falling away of the wicked must come first.

² That you should not be soon shaken *in* mind or troubled, neither by spirit, nor by word or letter, as through us, as *if* the Day of Christ is at hand. ³ Let not anyone deceive you by any means. For *that Day shall not come* unless there first comes a falling away, and the man of sin shall be revealed, the son of perdition, **2nd Thessalonians 2:2-3.**

³⁹ **And knew not until the flood came, and took them all away; so shall also the coming of the Son of Man be.** ⁴⁰ **Then shall two be in the field; the one shall be taken, and the other left.** ⁴¹ **Two women shall be grinding at the mill; the one shall be taken, and the other left.** ⁴² **Watch therefore: for ye know not what hour your Lord does come, Matthew 24:39-42, {Luke 17:34}.**

²¹ *For the upright shall dwell in the land, and the perfect shall remain in it,* ²² But the wicked shall be cut off from the earth, and the transgressors shall be rooted out of it, **Proverbs 2:21-22.**

Scripture speaks about the wicked, the unjust, and the unrighteous, that these are attributes that God hates and despises for His people.

Why then would a just and righteous God want His people living under such oppression and tyranny? Thus, in the fullness of time (in God's timing), the wicked will be removed from the earth, and the saints of God shall realize their full potential, and they shall shine.

The church, over the years, has taught its people to look towards the rapture of the church, implying that God would save His feeble and wayward people from this wicked world and the wiles of the devil. This might be a comforting thought to some; however, there are people who have chosen to give themselves over to the devil and his dark spirits and to embrace the evil Babylonian world's system.

God will remove these people and this evil system from His earth. Otherwise, the system itself would further enslave God's people in bondage, and God will restore a godly system as it was meant to be. Even after this happens, unclean spirits will still exist in the world, and God's people will still have temptations and challenges to overcome. However, with the evil system removed and a holy and righteous system now in place, the believers will be able to shine, fulfilling the scripture, "For the earnest expectation of the creation waits for the manifestation of the sons of God," **Romans 8:19.**

The great and terrible day of the Lord.

The outcome of that day will ultimately be great for God's people and terrible for those who have given themselves over to evil.

And Jehovah shall utter His voice before His army; for His camp *is* very great; for strong *is He* who does His Word. For the day of Jehovah *is* great and very terrible; and who can stand it? **Joel 2:11.**

¹ He who dwells in the secret place of the Most High shall rest *under* the shadow of the Almighty. . . . ⁸ Only with thine eyes shalt thou behold and see the reward of the wicked, **Psalm 91:1, 8.**

Let the sinners perish from the earth, and let the wicked be no more. Bless Jehovah, O my soul. Praise Jehovah! **Psalm 104:35.**

However, after this day, there will still be temptations from unclean spirits on the earth to overcome, such as spirits of lying, jealousy, pride, fear, infirmity, etc. (to see a further list, [click here](#)). Whereas, the evil system that was keeping God's people in bondage will be crumbling and being replaced by a righteous system, and the evil ones who schemed and imposed such a system will be gone.

This will now be the time for God's people to rise up, awaken to who they are in Christ Jesus, boldly speak His powerful Word, seeing signs and wonders to follow, **Mark 16:20.** And as believers we are well able to do so, for scripture tells us that; He who is in us is greater than he who is in the world, **1st John 4:4.**

For mankind was called after creation to "subdue" the earth, **Genesis 1:28.** This will be a time for the believers and the church to rise up with great power, signs, and wonders and to usher in the great harvest of the end of the age, that many souls shall be saved. Therefore said He unto them, **The harvest truly is great, but the laborers are few: pray ye therefore the Lord of the harvest, that He would send forth laborers into His harvest, Luke 10:2.**

Thus, do not view God removing the evil from this world just as a wishful thought; it is scriptural and is set to bring in a new era.

⁴ Behold, God is mine helper: the Lord is with them that uphold my soul. ⁵ He shall reward evil to my enemies; cut them off in Your truth, *Psalm 54:4-5*.

A prayer to the Father:

The Reverse RAPTURE

And Moses said unto the people, Fear ye not, stand still, and see the salvation of the LORD, which He will shew to you to day: for the Egyptians whom ye have seen to day, ye shall see them again no more for ever, *Exodus 14:13*.

The parable of the wheat and the tares

²⁴ Another parable put he forth unto them, saying, **The kingdom of heaven is likened unto a man which sowed good seed in his field: ²⁵ But while men slept, his enemy came and sowed tares among the wheat, and went his way. ²⁶ But when the blade was sprung up, and brought forth fruit, then appeared the tares also. ²⁷ So the servants of the householder came and said unto him, Sir, didst not thou sow good seed in thy field? from whence then hath it tares? ²⁸ He said unto them, An enemy has done this. The servants said unto him, Wilt thou then that we go and gather them up? ²⁹ But he said, Nay; lest while ye gather up the tares, ye root up also the wheat with them. ³⁰ Let both grow together until the harvest: and in the time of harvest I will say to the reapers, Gather ye together first the tares, and bind them in bundles to burn them: but gather the wheat into my barn, *Matthew 13:24-30*.**

If we are open to learn from this parable and the other like it, the parable of the dragnet, *Matthew 13:47-50*, and not just take it as a mysterious riddle or a way to scare, entice, and lead nonbelievers back on the pathway towards God. What we can take away from this parable that Jesus gave us, is that God has His people and the enemy (the devil) has his people.

But these, as natural brute beasts, made to be taken and destroyed, speak evil of the things that they understand not; and shall utterly perish in their own corruption; ^{2nd} *Peter 2:12*.
